Parents are the experts on their families

Paperwork is designed to be strengths-based to assist families in identifying their strengths and build upon them.

Core Values
Humility

Educational materials are inclusive and culturally sensitive.

Training with staff to identify implicit bias and be respectful of each family's values/culture.

Family Partnership Agreements -
Establish goals that are a partnership - PE and family put forth effort to achieve

Reviewing participation agreement & consent form with families so they are well-informed.

STANDARD 3

EHS and PAT supply referrals and resources to community agencies.

EHS and PAT both promote the idea of Parents as a child's first & foremost teacher.

We provide parent trainings that connect local professionals with our parents for conversation and education.

We empower parents to advocate for their child's education and well-being.

Supporting relationships & communication between families + new incoming professionals

Support families in knowing what to expect in new program / service

Ask parents / caregivers what supports they need for transitional times.

Connect families w/ others / families who have gone through similar transitions

Partner w/ cultural or community organization for supports (ex: refugee population)
